We've had a wonderful few weeks of learning in Year 3/4 and are excited to share what the class has been working on across our subjects.

### **English – Persuasive Writing**

Students have been exploring persuasive texts, learning how to structure strong arguments and use convincing language. They've enjoyed taking on real-life topics and practising how to support their opinions with reasons and evidence.

### **Mathematics – Fractions in Action**

Our focus in Maths has been on fractions and their many real-life applications. Students are developing confidence in recognising, comparing, and applying fractions through hands-on activities and problem-solving tasks, such as sharing, cooking, farming rations and measurement challenges.



### **Science – Heat Investigations**

In Science, we are investigating heat and its sources. The class has enjoyed carrying out experiments to explore how heat moves and the impact it has on everyday objects and materials.



### **HASS – Holiday Destinations**

In HASS, students are researching two distinct places around the world to compare their

similarities and differences. This has been a research-heavy task that is helping them build their inquiry skills, as well as broaden their global knowledge.
